Monthly contest ribbons will be awarded as follows: 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and Honorable Mentions. The number of Honorable Mentions is 10% of the total entries in a class for the month. No honorable mentions will be given in any class of less than 12 entries.

Winners are allotted points for each ribbon they win as follows:

1st.....8 points

2nd 6 points

3rd.....4 points

4th.....2 points

HM.....1 point

Points are accrued to move from Novice to Unlimited.

Black and White from Novice to Unlimited: 60 points

Slides from Novice to Unlimited: 50 points

Color Prints from Novice to Unlimited: 80 points

Once a club member has reached Unlimited in any category, he/she continues to earn points towards certificates as follows:

1st 50 points.....Bronze Certificate

2nd 50 points.....Silver Certificate

3rd 50 points.....Gold Certificate

4th 50 points.....Platinum Certificate

5th 50 points.....Masters Certificate

The member accruing the highest total points in a category (Monochrome prints, color prints, slides) shall receive the following Photographer of the Year Awards.

Monochrome Prints.....The Margaret H. Bevan Award
Color Prints.....The John R. Boykin Award
