



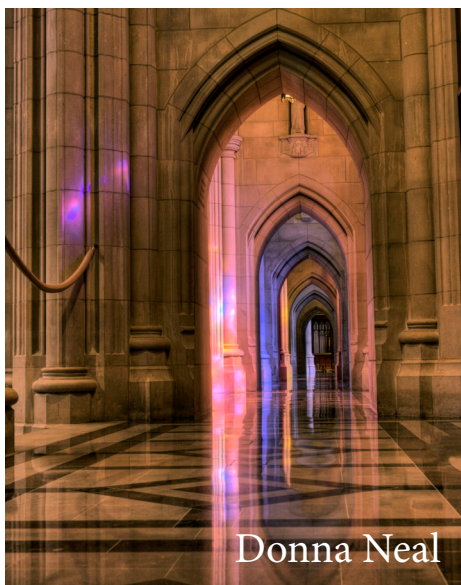

February Field Trip to the National Air and Space Museum Udvar-Hazy Center

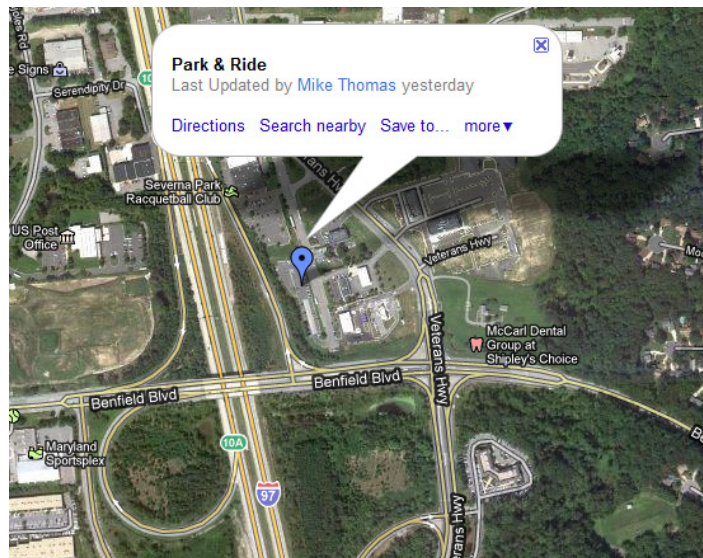
Our February 12th field trip is to the [National Air and Space Museum Udvar-Hazy Center](#).

states that tripods are prohibited.

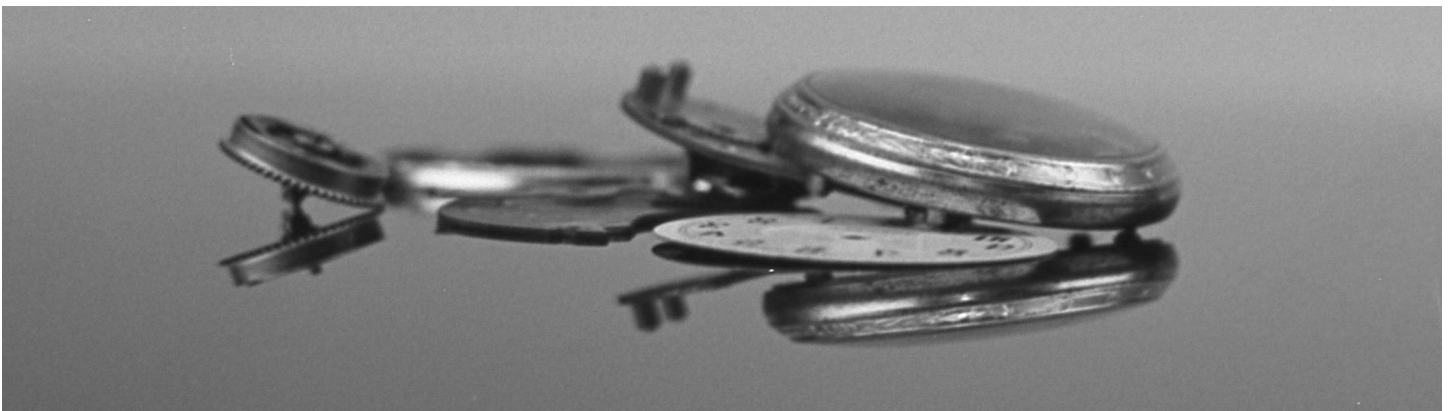

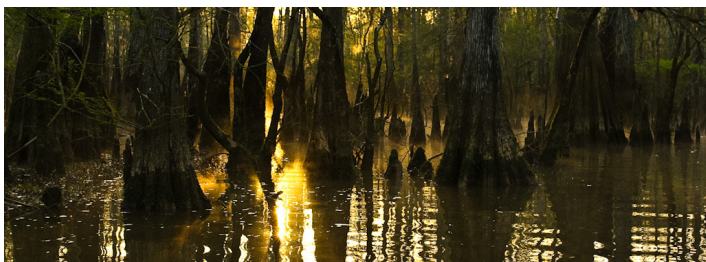

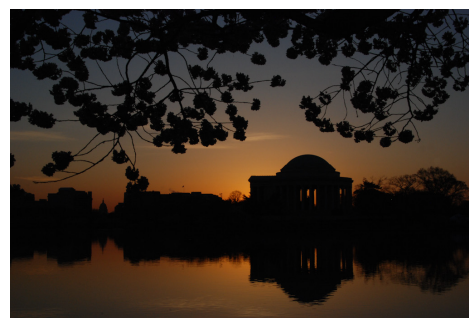

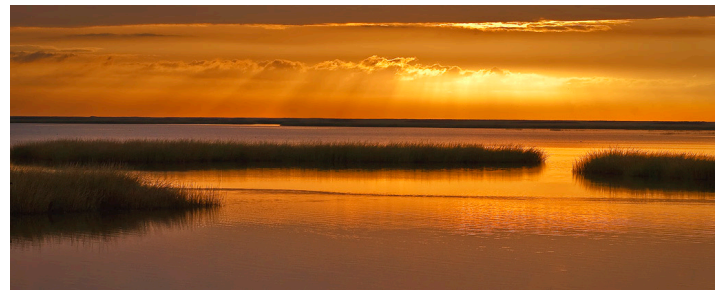

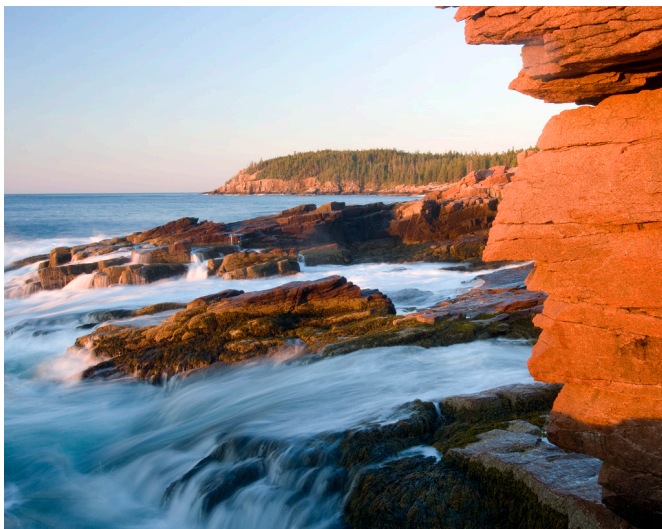

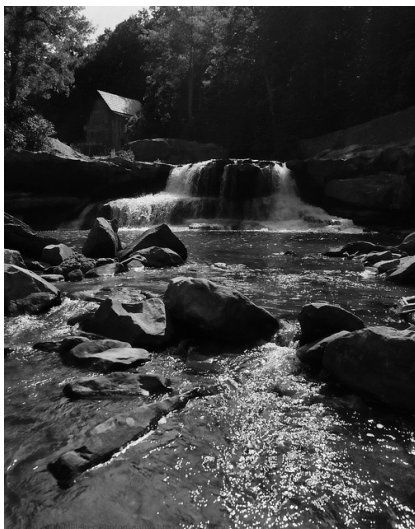

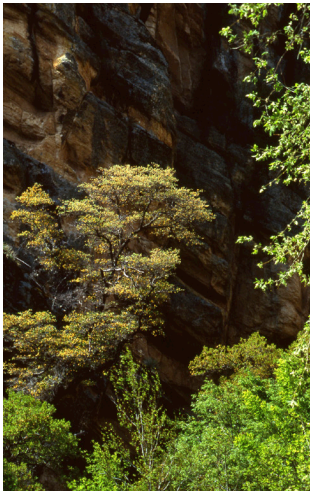

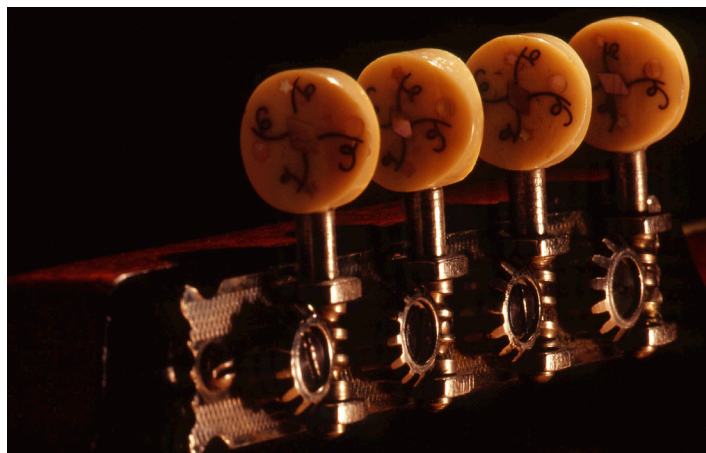
