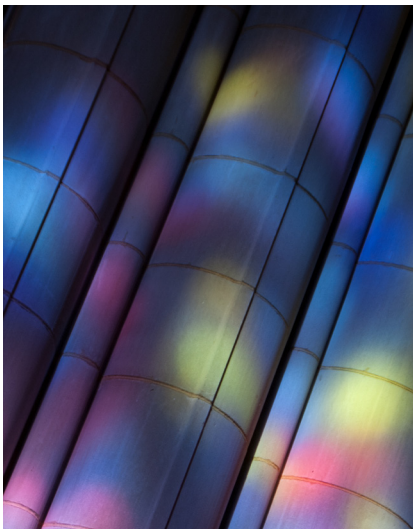

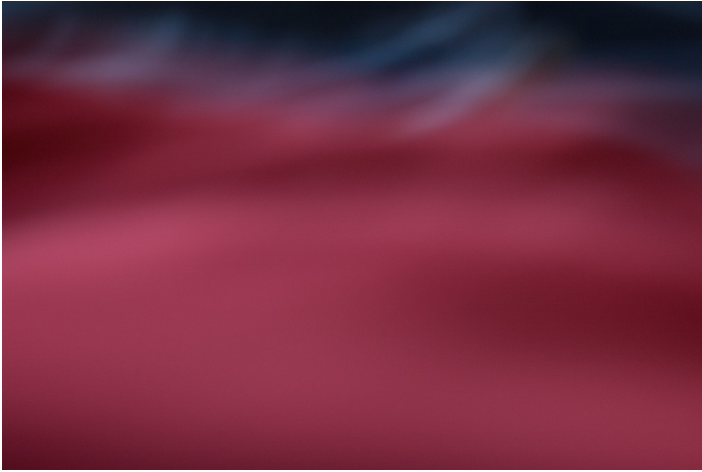

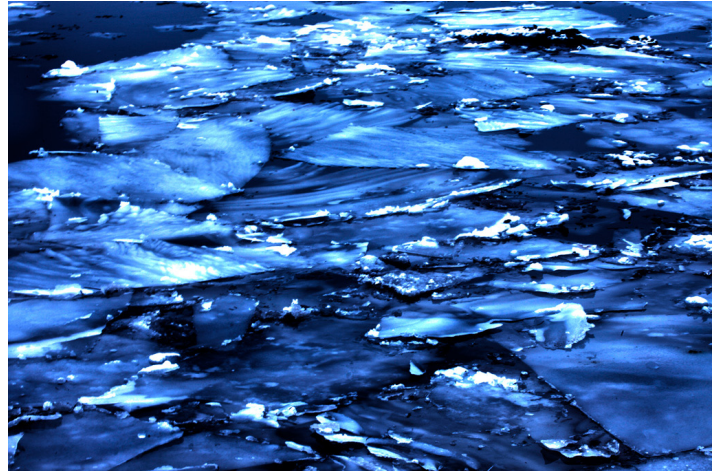

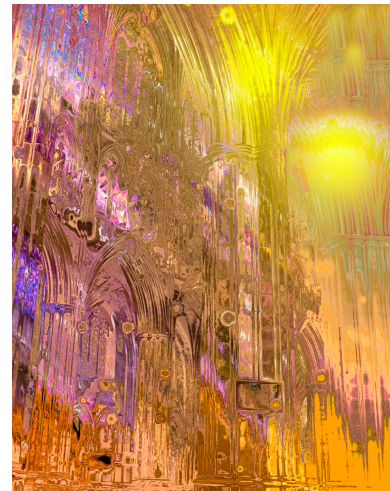

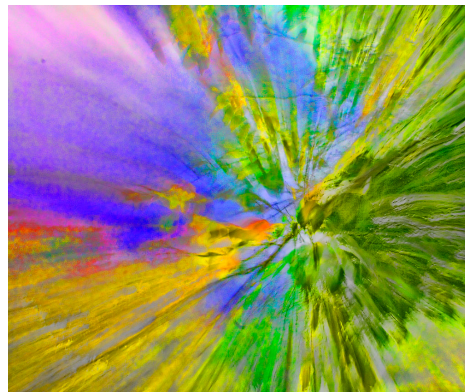

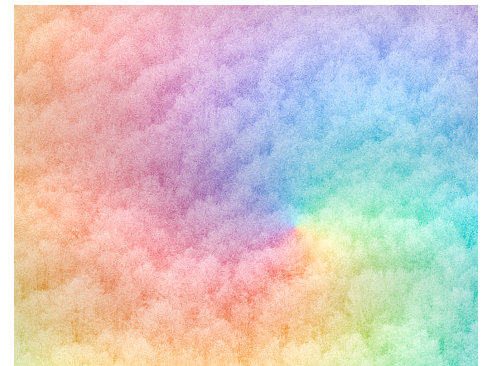

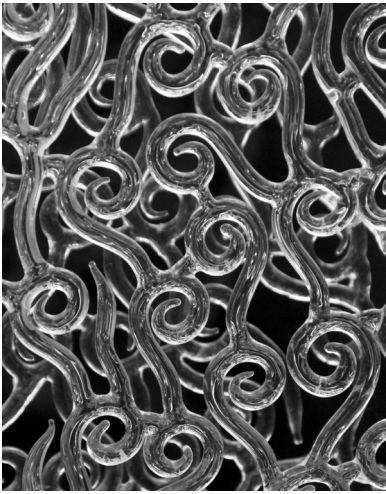

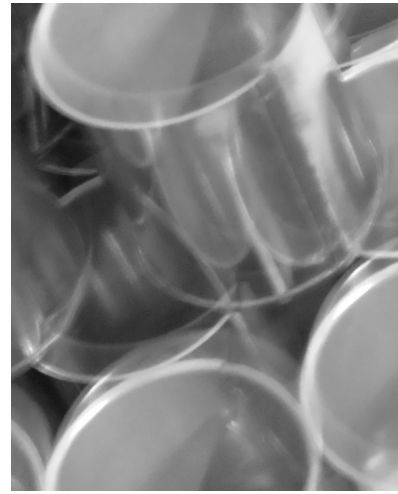

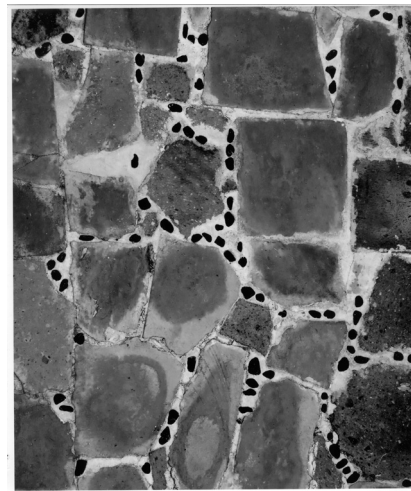

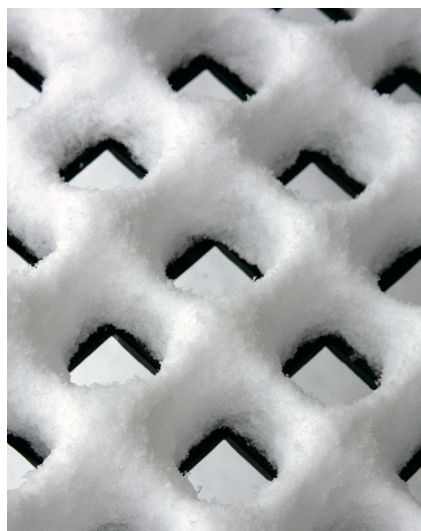
2nd Place - Christine Metzgar - Concentric Curves

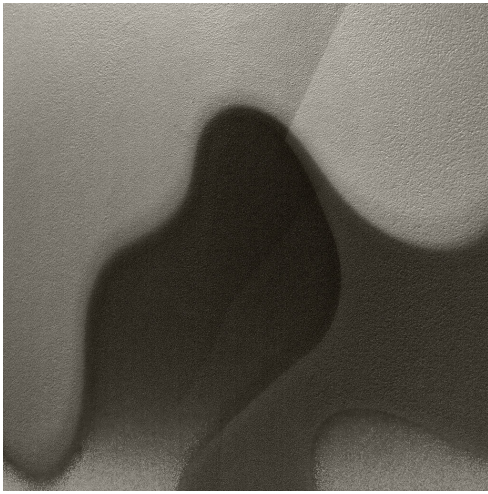

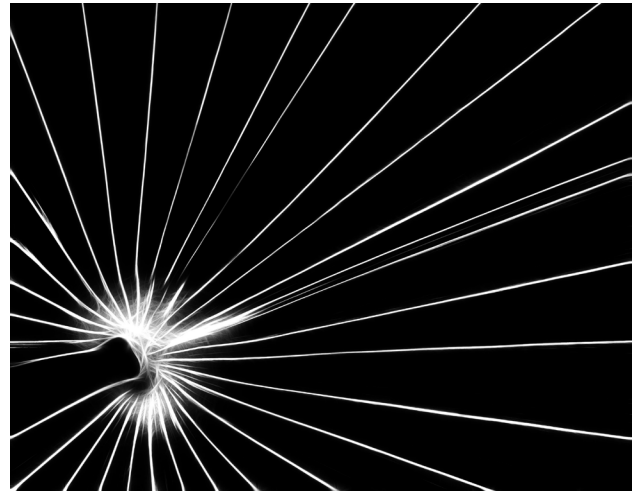

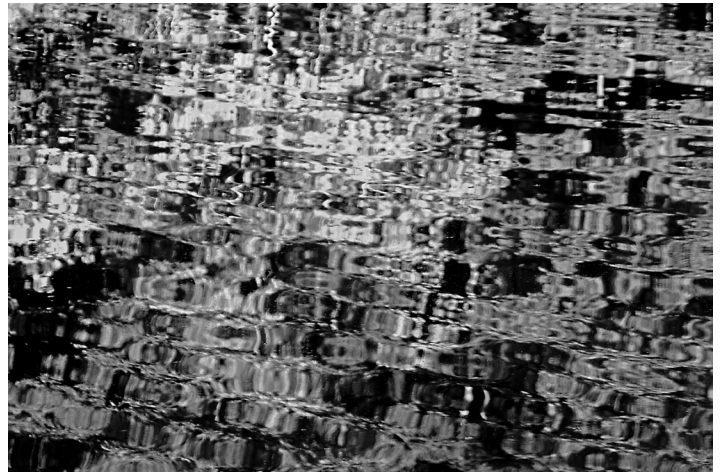

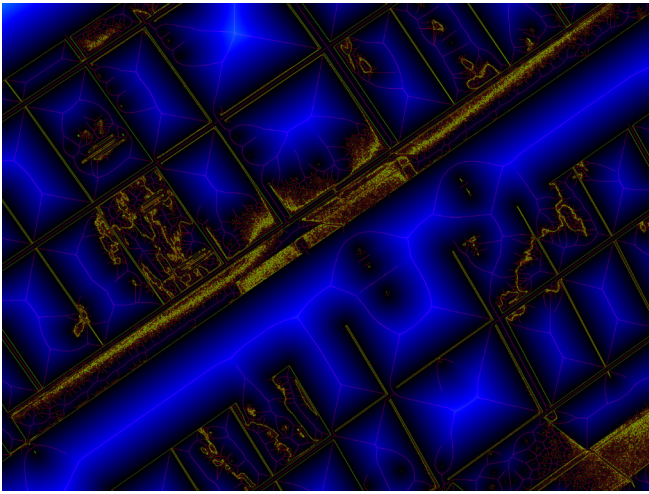

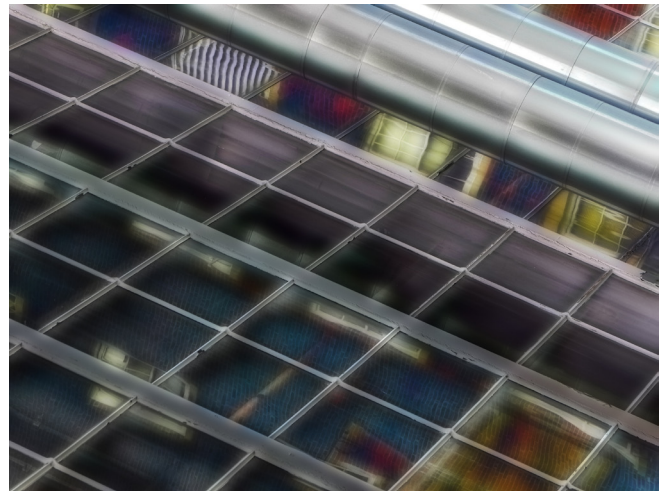

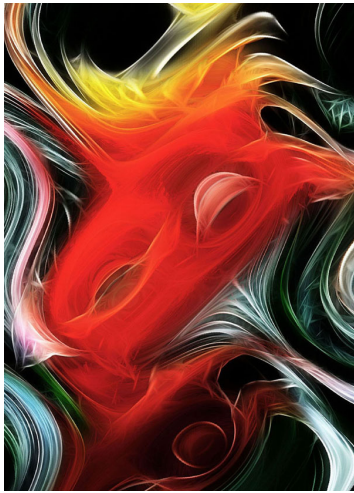
April Field Trip - St. Michael's

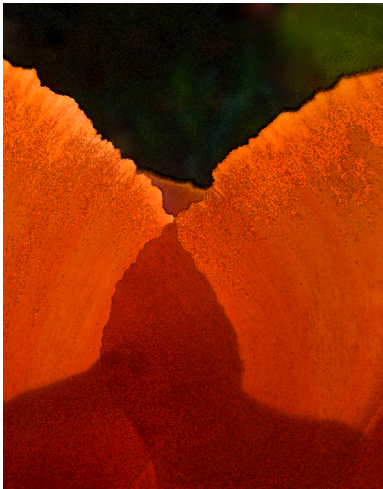

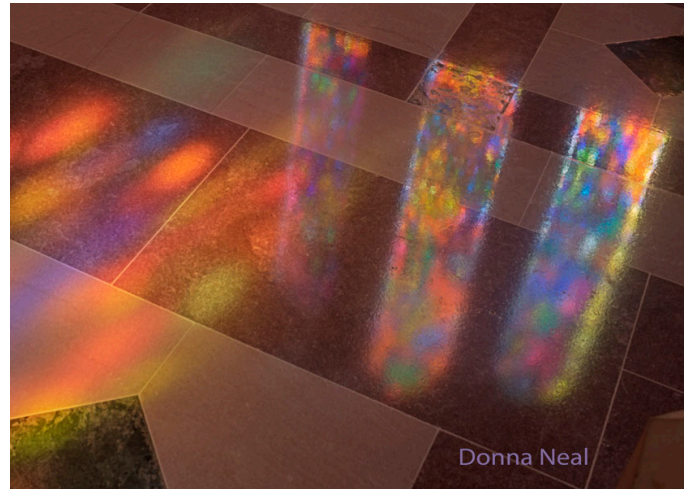

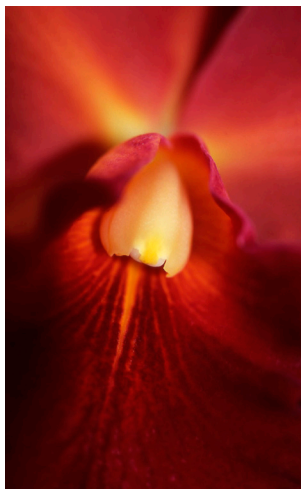
