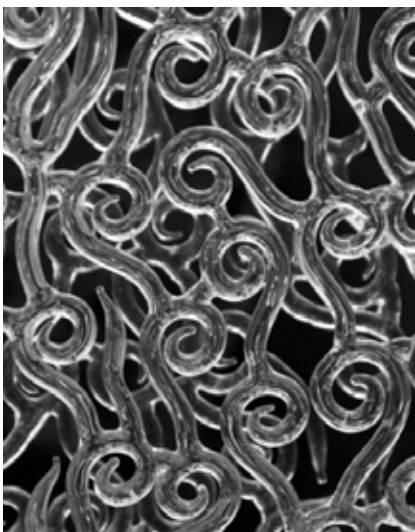

Mike Thomas has a photograph that has been accepted into the juried Horizon Workshop's Alumni Exhibition.

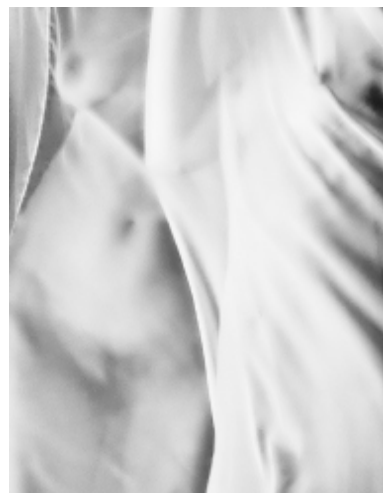
The exhibition will hang from July 1st through 31st at GALLERY 919, 919 N. Market Street, Wilmington, DE 19801.

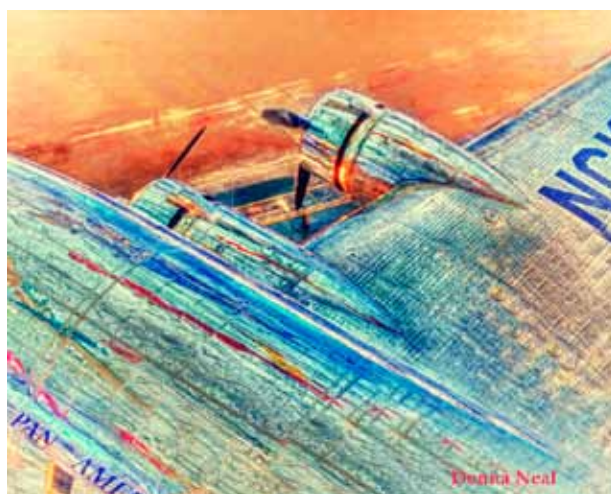

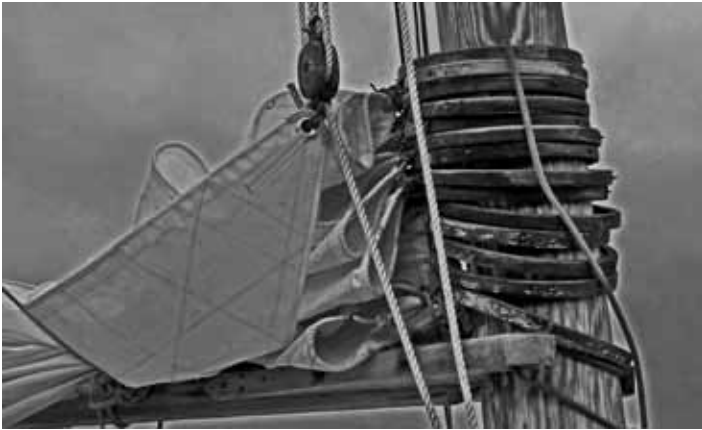

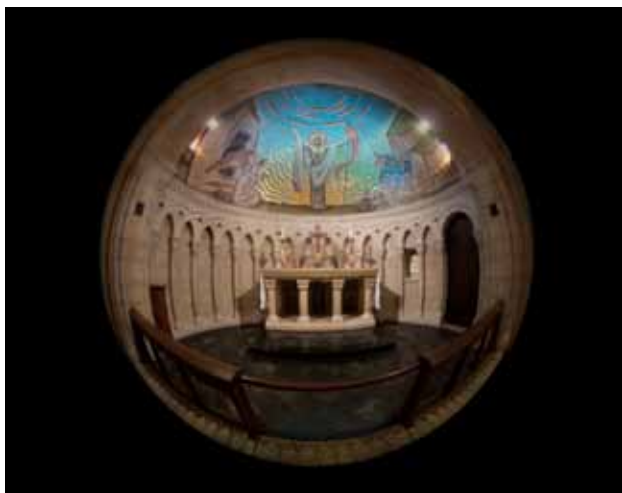

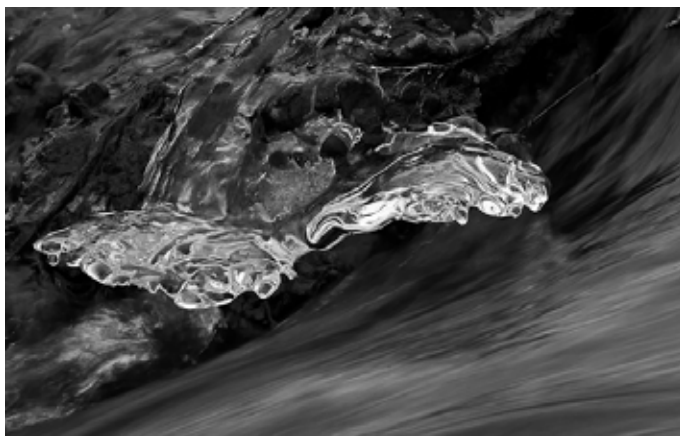
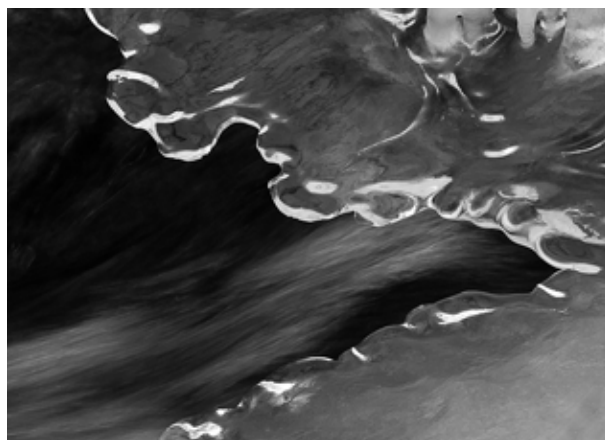


Congratulations To Bob Miller
