## Program - Quinn Jacobson



New speaker for March 31. Quinn Jacobson will be giving a talk on his new project using Collodio-Albumen Negatives and Gum Over Palladium Prints.

Quinn Jacobson is an internationally recognized artist and educator. He was instrumental in reviving the Wet Plate Collodion process in Europe (2006-2011). He has an M.F.A. in historic photographic processes specializing in the wet plate collodion process. He's published four books on the process. As of 2022, he is working on a new project using the Collodio-Albumen Dry Plate process and Gum Over Palladium printing. The work is about the Ute

Indians that once inhabited the land where he now lives. Quinn lives in the Rocky Mountains of Colorado with his wife, Jeanne, and his cat, Moshe. He works as a full-time artist and part-time educator in historic photographic processes.

## Field Trip - Cherry Blossom Festival


Please join the Arundel Camera Club field trip, March 26 2022, to the Cherry Blossom Festival, Tidal Basin, Washington, DC.







Meetings alternate between programs of informative speakers, photographic assignments, and photographic competitions. Competitions give us a chance to show off our work and to get constructive critiques from our judges. Ribbons are awarded for first through fourth place and honorable mention. Normally we have competitions for color prints, monochrome prints, and digital images. Currently we are only holding digital competitions. Competitions are held for both novice and unlimited club members. Awards are awarded at the end of year banquet. The club also has monthly photographic field trips to locations of interest. This is a chance to go out and practice what we learned during programs, a time to socialize with other club members, and a chance to do a little photographic exploration.
